
# From Capacity to Success: HSIs, Title V, and Latino Students

Title V is a federal competitive grant providing five years of funding to HSIs to expand capacity, quality, & the educational achievement of Latinos & other low-income students

## **HSIs & Title V Funding**


#### Growth: HSIs & Title V Recipients

## Title V & Latino Student Success

The majority of Title V recipients (70%) invested funding in activities related to Latino student success:

33% Faculty & curriculum development

26% Student support services

11% Fund & administrative management
