## Overview

*Excelencia* in Education has been tracking the numbers and growth of Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs), a critical group of institutions enrolling Latino students, since the founding of the organization 20 years ago. HSIs are defined in federal law as accredited and degree-granting public or private nonprofit institutions of higher education with 25 percent or more total undergraduate Hispanic full-time equivalent (FTE) student enrollment. These institutions were first recognized in federal law in 1994.

*Excelencia* in Education has shared analysis on HSIs since we began (2004) and releases the list of institutions meeting the basic definition every year. In addition, *Excelencia* developed the Emerging HSIs (eHSIs) category, institutions with 15-24.9 percent undergraduate full-time equivalent Hispanic enrollment, to track the growth of potential HSIs in 2009. *Excelencia* popularized the eHSIs category and HSIs with graduate programs (gHSIs), a subset of HSIs, by tracking and releasing annual analyses on these institutions as well. This factbook includes factsheets on these groups of institutions along with the lists of HSIs, eHSIs, and gHSIs for 2022-23, the latest academic year of publicly available data, using *Excelencia* in Education's analysis of U.S. Department of Education, National Center for Education Statistics (NCES), Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS), 1994 through 2022 Fall Enrollment, Institutional Characteristics, and Completions Surveys. ## Foreword


Over 30 years ago, two sentences were added to the Higher Education Act that continue to impact Latino student success today. Those two sentences laid out the purpose and program authority for the Developing Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs) program, known commonly today as Title V. The purpose of the program is to “expand educational opportunities for, and improve the academic attainment of, Hispanic students” and to “expand and enhance the academic offerings, program quality, and institutional stability” of institutions educating the majority of Hispanic students—HSIs. The purpose is carried out through the second sentence—providing competitive grants to enable HSIs to “improve and expand their capacity to serve Hispanic students and other low-income individuals.”

Today, HSIs still enroll the majority of Latino students—our latest analysis shows that HSIs represent about 20 percent of institutions of higher education but enroll over 60 percent of all Latino undergraduates. HSIs are meeting the core purpose of expanding educational opportunities for Hispanic students, but the majority of these institutions have become HSIs due to demography and geography, and not intentionality or impact.


Over the last 20 years *Excelencia* has conducted analysis to frame issues with a Latino lens, inform the field of what is working, and deconstruct the “S” in HSIs to better understand intentionality and impact. Our first publication in 2004 was “Latino Student Success at Hispanic-Serving Institutions.” Since this release, *Excelencia* has served as a national authority on the history, practices, and effectiveness of HSIs while expanding our expectations of what institutions must do to serve Latino, and all, students. *Excelencia* has released over 25 issue briefs on HSIs, over 50 factsheets/infographics, maintains 29 years of data on HSIs, created the Emerging HSIs (eHSIs) category to track the pipeline of potential HSIs, and developed an approach to identify HSIs with graduate programs (gHSIs).

*Excelencia* believes institutions must do more than just enroll students to fulfill the social contract with students that choose to pursue their educational goals with them. While the federal government has appropriated funds for competitive grants to increase the capacity of HSIs, *Excelencia* takes a step further and works with institutions that go beyond enrolling Hispanic students to more intentionally SERVE their Latino, and all, students. We even launched the Seal of *Excelencia* in 2018 with a framework that aligns data, evidence-based practices, and leadership to distinguish those institutions that are intentionally serving Latino, and all, students and leading higher education nationally by showing what is possible with an asset-based and student-centered commitment to our students.

We are honored to work with our community of common cause, including many HSIs, as they prioritize their journey to intentionally serve Latino, and all, students to meet their educational goals.

# Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs) Factsheet: 2022-23

The mission of *Excelencia* in Education is to accelerate Latino student success in higher education. A critical set of institutions enrolling Latino students is Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs).

## Background

The classification of Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs) was formally recognized in federal legislation for capacity-building support to improve the access and quality of education for Latino and other low-income students. HSIs are defined as accredited, degree-granting public or private not-for-profit institutions of higher education with 25% or more total undergraduate Hispanic full-time equivalent student (FTE) enrollment.<sup>1</sup> To create this list, *Excelencia* uses the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS), from the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) and maintained by the U.S. Department of Education. The information presented below is the most recent data as of February 2024.

## Overview: 2022-23

- **HSIs represent a small segment of higher education and yet enroll the majority of Latino undergraduates.** There are 600 HSIs, which represent 20% of all colleges and universities and enroll 63% of all Latino undergraduates.
- **The number of HSIs is growing significantly.** The number of HSIs has increased to 600 in 2022-23 up from 571 in 2021-22 (an increase of 29 institutions, compared to an increase of 12 the year before).
- **The majority of Seal of *Excelencia*-certified institutions are now HSIs.** Of the 39 Seal of *Excelencia*-certified institutions, 37 are now HSIs. These colleges and universities have demonstrated their commitment to intentionally serve their Latino students, and all, students.
- **Latino representation at HSIs is high.** Almost half of students enrolled at HSIs (45%) are Latino.

## Location

- **HSIs are geographically concentrated.** HSIs are located in 28 states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico. California has the most HSIs (172), followed by Texas (111), Puerto Rico (56), and New York (39).
- **Locations not generally known for having large Latino populations have HSIs.** Arkansas, Indiana, Kansas, Ohio, and Oklahoma each have at least one HSI.
- **The majority of HSIs are located in cities or suburbs.** Over 80% of HSIs are either in a city (314) or suburb (180), while less than 20% are in towns (60) or rural areas (46).

## Sector

- **A majority of HSIs are four-year institutions.** Overall, 60% of HSIs are four-year institutions (public—30%; private—30%), and 40% are two-year institutions (public—39%; private—1%).
- **The majority of HSIs are public institutions.** Overall, 69% of HSIs are public and 31% are private.

## Emerging HSIs (eHSIs)

- **Emerging HSIs represent a growing subset of colleges and universities.** There are 412 eHSIs (institutions with 15-24.9% undergraduate full-time equivalent Hispanic enrollment), representing 13% of all institutions.
- **The number of eHSIs continues to increase.** The number of eHSIs has increased by 11 (from 401 to 412).
- **The majority of states have at least one eHSI.** eHSIs are in 43 states and the District of Columbia, including Alabama, Hawaii, Iowa, Missouri, Nebraska, North Carolina, Tennessee, Utah, Wisconsin, and Wyoming.
- **The majority of eHSIs are four-year institutions.** Overall, 72% of eHSIs are four-year institutions (private—45%; public—27%), and 29% are two-year institutions (public—28%; private—1%).<sup>2</sup>

## HSIs with Graduate Programs (gHSIs)

- **More than a third of HSIs offer graduate degrees.** Of the 600 HSIs, 252 offer graduate degrees (42%).
- **gHSIs are concentrated geographically.** Two-thirds (67%) of gHSIs are in California (56), Texas (55), Puerto Rico (35), and New York (23).

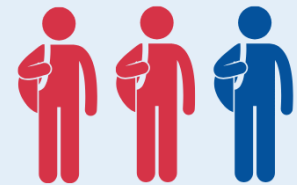

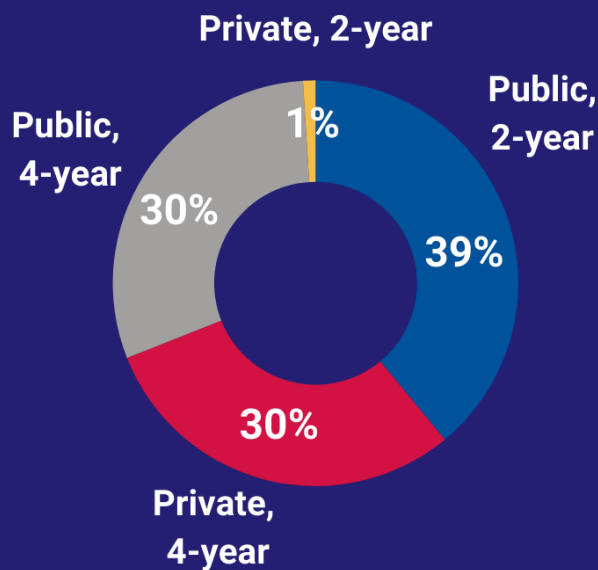

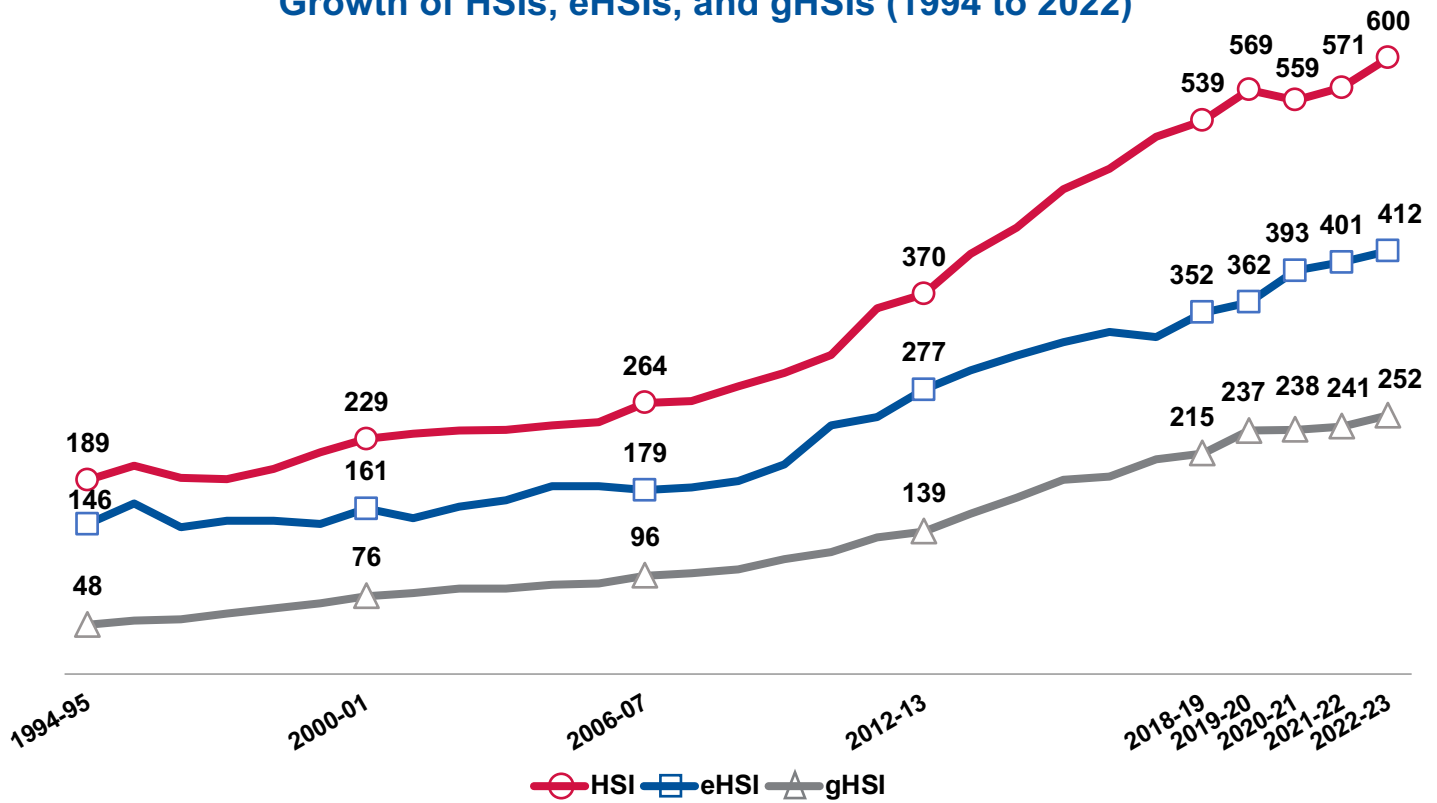

## Growth of HSIs, eHSIs, and gHSIs

### Growth of HSIs, eHSIs, and gHSIs (1994 to 2022)



#### Growth of Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs)

- **The number of HSIs has tripled since 1994-95.** In 2022-23, there are 600 HSIs, compared to 189 in 1994-95 – an increase of 411 institutions over 29 years (a 217% increase).
- **The growth of HSIs is due to the growth of Latino undergraduate student enrollment over time.** In 2022-23, HSIs enrolled over 1.4 million Latino FTE undergraduates, compared to 340,000 in 1994-95—an increase of about 1.1 million students (a 324% increase).

#### Growth of Emerging Hispanic-Serving Institutions (eHSIs)

- **The number of institutions on the cusp of becoming an HSI has grown significantly.** In 1994-95, there were 146 Emerging HSIs; in 2022-23, there are 412 Emerging HSIs (institutions with 15-24.9% undergraduate FTE Hispanic enrollment).<sup>3</sup>
- **Latino undergraduate student FTE enrollment has significantly increased at Emerging HSIs.** Since 1994-95, Latino undergraduate FTE enrollment at Emerging HSIs has increased from 114,561 to 353,122 in 2022-23, a 208% increase.

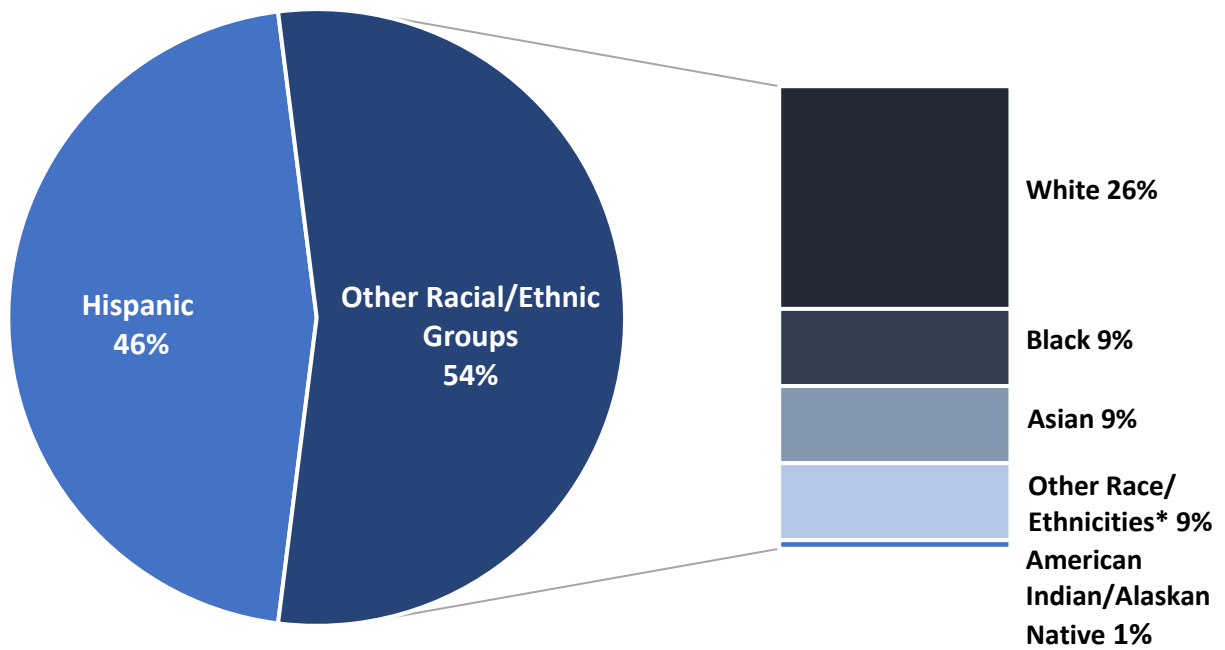
#### Growth of Hispanic-Serving Institutions with Graduate Programs (gHSIs)

- **The number of HSIs that offer graduate programs has increased.** In 2022-23, 252 HSIs offered graduate programs, compared to 48 HSIs with graduate programs in 1994-95, a 425% increase.
- **Latino graduate student enrollment at HSIs with graduate programs has significantly increased.** In 2022-23, there were 139,010 Latino graduate students enrolled at HSIs, compared to 23,308 in 1994-95, a 496% increase.

<sup>3</sup> The number of Emerging HSIs fluctuate over the years as they lose eHSI status or move from Emerging HSIs to HSI status once they meet the Latino FTE enrollment threshold of 25%. *Excelencia* developed the Emerging HSIs (eHSI category) to track the growth of potential HSIs in 2009.

## Undergraduate Enrollment at HSIs by Race/Ethnicity, 2022-23

- **Almost half of students enrolled at HSIs are Hispanic.** While 46% of undergraduate students enrolled at HSIs are Hispanic, 54% are from other racial/ethnic groups.
- **HSIs enroll a diverse student body.** Over 26% of students are White, 9% are Black, and 9% are Asian.

## Top 10 HSIs Enrolling Latinos



\* The top 10 institutions are located in **six metro areas** – Los Angeles, CA, El Paso, TX, Dallas, TX, Houston, TX, Rio Grande Valley, TX, and Miami, FL.

### The top 10 HSIs enrolling Latinos are:

- **Also the top 10 institutions enrolling Latinos in the nation.** These 10 institutions enroll 8% of all Latino undergraduates in the country;
- **All public institutions.** There are more 4-year than 2-year institutions; and
- **Concentrated geographically.** Institutions are located in three states – Texas, California, and Florida.

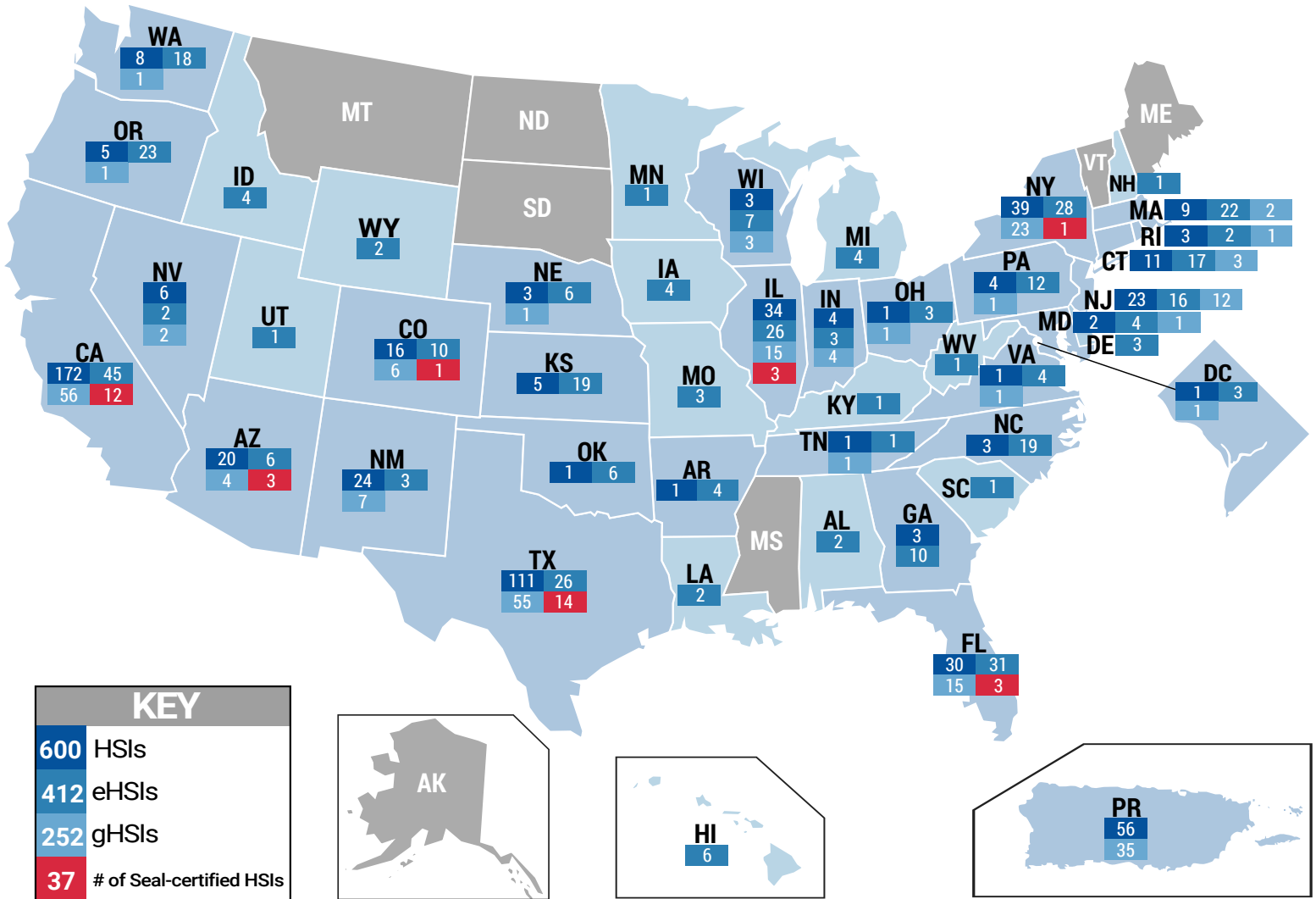
**Latino enrollment varies widely among the top 10 institutions.** Latino undergraduate student enrollment ranges from less than 20,000 to nearly 40,000 students and representation ranges from 41% to 95%.

Excelencia in Education has conducted analysis of Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs) since its founding to provide credible information on the number and distribution of HSIs nationwide each year, and to help inform understanding of this critical set of institutions enrolling and graduating Latino students.

In 2022-23, *Excelencia* analysis shows the number of higher education institutions with 25% or more undergraduate Hispanic student full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment – the federal definition of an HSI – rose to 600. They represent 20% of colleges/universities and enroll 63% of Latino undergraduates.

This map and table of institutions identified as HSIs shows that HSIs are geographically concentrated in 28 states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico, with the majority located in California, Texas, Puerto Rico, and New York.

**HSIs:** HSIs are institutions that have 25% or more undergraduate full-time equivalent (FTE) Hispanic enrollment.

**eHSIs:** Emerging HSIs (eHSIs) are institutions that have between 15% and 24.9% undergraduate FTE Hispanic enrollment. *Excelencia* developed the eHSI category to track growth of potential HSIs.

**gHSIs:** HSIs with graduate programs (gHSIs) are institutions that meet the enrollment definition of an HSI and offer graduate programs.

**Seal-certified HSIs:** Seal-certified HSIs are institutions that meet the enrollment definition of an HSI and have earned the Seal of *Excelencia*, a national certification for institutions that go beyond enrollment to intentionally serve Latino students.

## Introduction

The mission of *Excelencia* in Education is to accelerate Latino student success in higher education. A critical group of institutions enrolling and graduating Latino students are Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs).

The classification of Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs) was formally recognized in federal legislation for capacity-building support to improve the access and quality of education for Latino and other low income students. HSIs are defined as accredited, degree-granting public or private nonprofit institutions of higher education with 25% or more total undergraduate Hispanic full-time equivalent (FTE) student enrollment.<sup>1</sup>

**In 2022-23, 600 institutions met the enrollment definition of HSIs. HSIs represent 20% of colleges/universities and enroll 63% of Latino undergraduates.**

The list of institutions identified as HSIs in this analysis is not intended to designate eligibility for any specific program; rather, the list is meant to assist in considering and analyzing the institutions that meet the basic legislative definition of a Hispanic-Serving Institution. The following list of HSIs was created using data from the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS).<sup>2</sup>

## Seal Certified-HSIs

The Seal of *Excelencia* is a national certification of institutions that strive to go beyond enrollment to intentionally SERVE Latino students. Not all Seal-certified institutions are HSIs nor are all HSIs Seal-certified. *Excelencia* in Education developed a framework that integrates essential components of transformation (data, practice, and leadership) into a comprehensive institutional strategy for SERVING students. This framework represents learning from over 20 years of working with higher education institutions.<sup>3</sup>

## Introduction

The mission of *Excelencia* in Education is to accelerate Latino student success in higher education. A critical group of institutions enrolling and graduating Latino students are Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs).

HSIs are defined as accredited and degree-granting public or private nonprofit institutions of higher education with 25% or more undergraduate Hispanic full-time equivalent (FTE) student enrollment.<sup>1</sup> *Excelencia* developed the eHSI category—institutions with undergraduate FTE Hispanic enrollment of 15-24.9%—to track the growth of potential HSIs.

**There were 412 Emerging HSIs (eHSIs) in 2022-23, representing 13% of all colleges/universities and enrolling 15% of Latino undergraduates.**

While Emerging HSIs do not have the Latino student enrollment required to meet the definition of an HSI, these institutions may soon meet the criteria as their Latino enrollment grows. The following list of Emerging HSIs was created using data from the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS).<sup>2</sup>

## Seal Certified-eHSIs

The Seal of *Excelencia* is a national certification of institutions that strive to go beyond enrollment to intentionally SERVE Latino students. In the 2022-23 academic year, one eHSI was seal-certified.<sup>3</sup>

## Introduction

The mission of *Excelencia* in Education is to accelerate Latino student success in higher education. A critical group of institutions enrolling and graduating Latino students are Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs).

In 2022-23, nearly two-thirds of all Latino undergraduate students in higher education (63%) were enrolled in 600 institutions in the U.S. known as Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs).<sup>1</sup> HSIs represent 20% of all institutions of higher education. The majority of HSIs (60%) are 4-year institutions, and a smaller subset offer graduate programs.

**In 2022-23, 42% of HSIs offered graduate programs (252 HSIs).**

Of the 600 HSIs, 252 offered graduate degrees (162 offered doctoral degrees as the highest degree, 71 offered master's degrees, and 19 offered a post-master's certificate).

The list of institutions identified as HSIs with graduate programs in this analysis is not intended to designate eligibility for any specific program; rather, the list is meant to assist in considering and analyzing the institutions that meet the legislative definition of an HSI and offer graduate programs.<sup>2</sup> The following list of HSIs was created using data from the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS).<sup>3</sup>

## Seal Certified-gHSIs

The Seal of *Excelencia* is a national certification of institutions that strive to go beyond enrollment to intentionally SERVE Latino students. In the 2022-23 academic year, 28 gHSIs were seal-certified.<sup>4</sup>
