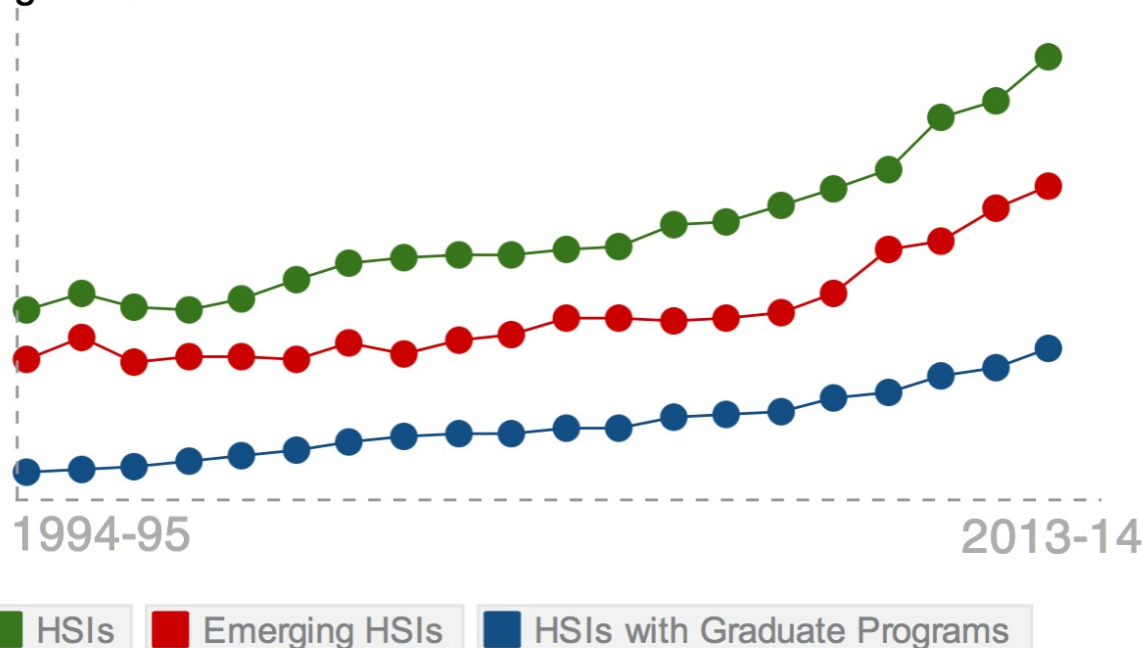


Hispanic-Serving Institutions [HSIs]

Growth: HSIs, Emerging HSIs, Graduate HSIs

HSIs with graduate programs increased by 225%, a higher rate than HSIs and Emerging HSIs

- The number of HSIs increased by 220 institutions, Emerging HSIs increased by 150 institutions, and HSIs with graduate programs increased by 108 institutions.

-HSIs with graduate programs experienced a higher rate of growth (225%), than HSIs (116%) and Emerging HSIs (103%).
