
## Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs)

## 10 Year Snapshot: HSIs, Emerging HSIs, & HSIs with Graduate Programs

The number of HSIs, Emerging HSIs, and HSIs with Graduate Programs have steadily increased.



- The number of HSIs increased by 167 institutions, Emerging HSIs increased by 113 institutions, and HSIs with graduate programs increased by 69 institutions.
- -HSIs with graduate programs increased at a faster rate (79%), than HSIs (69%), and Emerging HSIs (62%).
